## Early History

Lydians originally from Europe

 Small states throughout Asia Minor following fall of the Hittites

 10<sup>th</sup> century B.C.E. – dominated western Asia Minor (modern-day Turkey)

## Lydian Civilization

- 400 years of prosperity
- Mineral wealth
  - Especially gold and electrum
    - Electrum mixture of gold and silver found in riverbeds
- Controlled Asia Minor's trade routes
- Conquered by Persians (547 B.C.E.)

# Lydians Coined Money

- Before the Lydians, goods had to be traded for other goods
  - Only thing close to money were lumps of gold and silver, which had to be repeatedly weighed and tested for purity
- Lydians made standard-sized pieces of gold and silver and stamped them with their value
  - Invention of money
- Use of money spread quickly
  - Helped to spread international trade

### Government

- Capital Sardis trading center
- Ruled by a king

> Most famous king was Croesus – "as rich as

Croesus"
